Indeed, Catholic education is fundamentally about teaching and learning how to be truly human in the example of Jesus.

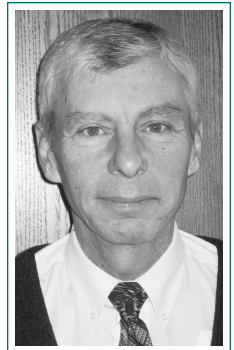

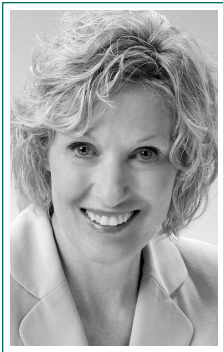

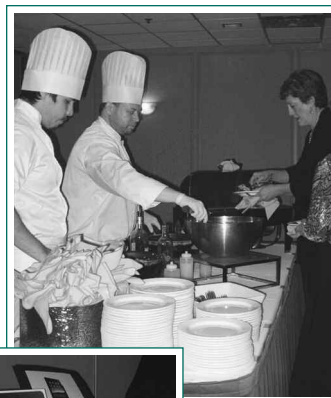

Grant Review

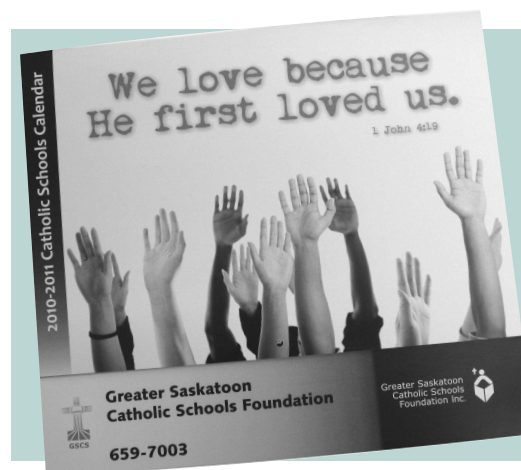
At its November Board of Directors' meeting, the Directors of Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools Foundation Inc. reviewed and approved 56 grant applications requesting the Foundation's financial support for a wide ranging array of student and staff faith development initiatives. The vast majority of applications were for activities promoting the faith development of our young people. The requests ranged from covering busing costs to provide students the opportunity to attend liturgies in local churches to honorariums for retreat teams; providing supplies to allow students in various grades to experience the spiritually enriching activity of iconography, to creating visual reminders of the core virtues of our Catholic faith through the creation of murals, stained glass projects and other art works. Students will learn more about the Byzantine Rite theology through activities, workshops and tours, bringing its theology, symbolism and rituals to life.

Many of the student retreats approved for funding had "Reaching Out to Transform the World" as their theme, enhancing the understanding of

our students of their unique privilege in life and the call by Christ to love one another. At the high school level, student retreats will focus on the Grade Twelve year, with graduating students given the opportunity to reflect on the significance and impact of 13 years of Catholic education and "what now." Other grade level retreats build the students' spiritual experience and deepen their understanding of their faith.

The funds for the grants are a result of the hard work of our school communities and the Schools Win Twice raffle held each fall. The 45% of the raffle proceeds that the Foundation receives goes to cover raffle expenses and fund grant

requests. Since 1993, Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools has received over \$3,400,000.00 from the Foundation through raffle proceeds, grants, donor directed, flow through grants and in-kind gifts to schools. The Foundation is sincerely appreciative of the generosity of its donors and supporters, both from within and outside of the school division. It is because of the financial support of our community that the Foundation can continue to provide support for initiatives leading to spiritual growth, educational excellence and enhanced learning opportunities for the community represented in Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools. ■
