

PARENT EDUCATION

Parent Centers are located in the following schools:

The goal is to assist and encourage parents and their children in early childhood years. The long term effect is to strengthen the healthy development of the child and strengthen parenting skills.

Once a week – morning or afternoon – parents along with their pre-school children attend programs designed especially to meet their needs. Parents have opportunities for parent education, nutrition, craft making and literacy experiences.

Children spend an hour in a rich learning environment and have shared play experiences and participate in a literacy program with the parents. For another hour childcare is provided while parents participate in their planned activities. During this time children have a nutritious snack and large muscle play experiences.

Janitorial, classroom space and some supplies are provided by the Catholic School Board, as well as a Coordinator. Additional funding is provided by the Bosco Columbus Board and the J.P. Mahoney Institute of the Family.
