<p>Where an end wall is close to the baseline, place protective gym mats or padding beyond the Akey® area.</p> <p>Extend protective end wall mats up the wall from the top of the backboard up the wall and a minimum width of 6 meters across the wall.</p> <p>Where a stage is close to the baseline, place gym mats over the edge of the stage and extend them to the floor.</p>	<p>Don't locate winch for moving backboards up and down directly under the supporting wall-mounted structure.</p> <p>Use a playing surface (indoor or outdoor) and surrounding area that is clean, free of all obstacles and provides good traction.</p> <p>Use protective padding on rectangular backboard edges in secondary school facilities.</p> <p>Ensure that only trained adults or students under supervision use motorized or hand winches to raise and lower baskets.</p>	<p>Teach skills in proper progression.</p> <p>Base games and activities on skills that are taught.</p> <p>If cross-court play involves immovable obstacles or confined space (e.g., doors and radiators under side baskets or wall close to the baseline) modify rules appropriately (e.g., no lay-ups).</p>	<p>Provide on-site supervision.</p>
