<p>Have a first aid kit available on site.</p> <p>Wear CSA approved hockey helmet with cage, gloves, elbow pads and throat protector.</p> <p>If using regulation hockey puck, wear full hockey equipment.</p> <p>Check sticks often for cracks and splinters.</p>	<p>Use ice surface that is free from debris and deep ruts.</p>	<p>No slap shots.</p> <p>No body contact or stick on body contact.</p> <p>Base games on skills that are taught.</p> <p>Modify the game to suit equipment available and ability of students.</p> <p>No goaltender unless all players are fully equipped.</p> <p>Outline and enforce all rules.</p> <p>Teach skills in proper progression.</p> <p>Parent permission is required.</p>	<p>Provide on-site supervision.</p>
