

TRACK AND FIELD DISCUS

DISCUS is not a recommended in-class activity for students from kindergarten to grade 9 and is a high-risk activity at all grade levels. Schools are encouraged to consider alternative program options to replace high-risk activities. Teachers who wish to instruct a high-risk activity like discus require written permission from the board of education.

<p>Use a discus that is of a size appropriate for the age, gender and physical maturity of the student.</p> <p>Use a discus that is free of cracks, chips and other damage. Check the discus regularly for damage.</p> <p>Provide protective screening around the throwing area. (A baseball screen may provide suitable protection.)</p>	<p>Use a landing area that is well marked and free of people during the activity.</p> <p>Choose a throwing area that is free of obstacles and completely closed to traffic. (No other activity in the area where discus is taking place.)</p> <p>Ensure that the discus circle area provides safe footing.</p>	<p>Require instructor and students not throwing to be behind thrower (behind a screen).</p> <p>Teach skills in proper progression.</p> <p>Establish safe throwing and retrieving procedures.</p> <p>Instruct students in safety prior to teaching and practice.</p> <p>Establish precautions to ensure the safety of all students before any activity with the discus begins.</p>	<p>Provide constant visual supervision.</p>
