

# Welcome to École Sister O'Brien School's FRENCH IMMERSION Kindergarten

## Registration Day – Monday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 @ 9: 00 a.m.

- Please be prepared to fill out registration form (if you have not yet done so.)
- Please bring Baptismal certificate (if you have one), Birth certificate and health card. (if you have not done so.)
- Please pay registration fee of \$45.00 (cash or cheque payable to Sister O'Brien School)

Expect to stay no more than 30 minutes in the gym. There will NOT be any activities for students.

### Registration fee will cover:

- crayons
- pencils
- markers
- glue / glue sticks
- erasers
- pencil crayons
- water cups
- 1 inch binder for portfolio
- Special art supplies
- excursions
- chartered bus fees
- cultural / fine art and drama performances

### Supply List: (what you need to supply for school)

- 1 pair of slip-on Velcro runners for daily use (no laces please even if your child is proficient at tying. Shoes have a tendency to come loose often.) These runners will remain at school all year and may need to be replaced as the children grow or the shoes wear out. Please label with your child's name.
- 1 change of clothing (underpants, pants, shirt, 2 pair of socks) to keep at school in case of accidents. These clothes are not just for potential bathroom accidents but spills from snack and lunch or puddles at recess can cause a need to change for comfort. Please fold and put clothing in a large ziplock bag with your child's name on it.
- 1 school bag needed daily, which should be large enough to fit a lunch kit, library books, take-home crafts and notes from school.
- 1 lunch kit for snacks and/or lunch
- 1 large box of Kleenex to use as a class. No need to label.
- 1 reusable plastic container of homemade playdoh (recipe below)
- 3 packages of 'special craft items' from Dollarama/Dollar store (ie: colored feathers, foam glue-ons, stickers, stamps, ribbons, NO sparkles or glitter glue) OR recycled items (paper rolls, string, pieces of cloth, puzzle pieces).  
These will be used to add to our 'crafting' center. Be creative!

I would like to have a 'How It's Made' center and need to have items that can be taken apart with mini screwdrivers.  
(ie: old VCR or DVD players, old video game machines, small kitchen appliances, cameras, computer towers etc.)

## First day of School will be either Thursday, Sept. 2 or Friday, Sept. 3, 2010.

**Do Not bring supplies to school on registration day. Bring ALL supplies on the first day of school.**

### PLAYDOH RECIPE

- 1 cup flour**
- 1 cup boiling water**
- 2 tbsp cream of tartar**
- ½ cup salt**
- 1 tbsp oil**
- Food coloring**

**Mix and kneed together.**
