

Safe Positive Schools Funding Guidelines

Schools through their Safe Positive School Communities are invited to apply for funding for projects which meet the following criteria:

1. The project should assist the implementation and/or maintenance of the social skills curricula supported by Safe Positive Schools Committee; that is, *Peaceworks*, *Second Step*, *Lions Quest*, peer mediation and student conferences, and high school student leadership projects. Other appropriate projects will be considered. All projects will require an outcomes report submitted to the Chair of the committee. Preference will be given to projects which have a school wide focus and encourage parental involvement, social skills development, and alignment of Gospel Values.
2. The project is designed to purchase student materials, teacher resources and/or support staff and parental inservice. The Safe Positive Schools Committee will not fund conference attendance for staff. Support can be provided on related topics like positive discipline, anti-bullying, character education, student leadership programs, parental programs, or programs which meet unique needs.

Please complete the following application and submit to the Safe Positive Schools Committee (Marc Colleaux and Carol Sarich) at your convenience. Our committee considers applications at each meeting. The annual maximum award available to any school is \$1000.00. Please forward the application by e-mail. Remember that Safe Positive School Awards when granted, must be spent within the school year. Our budget is based on the school year and not the calendar year. Please ensure that original copies of bills are forwarded to MaryLynn Kemp at the Board Office **prior to June 1 of the school year the award is granted.**

Application must be submitted no later than May 1st. The award allocated must be spent prior to June 1st of the school year in which you received the award.
